Program Description

The program focuses on economics and development studies, studying economic theory and its application for economic development, specifically in developing countries. This program also studies the latest strategic issues on social-economic that contribute to development policy, including technological and institutional side.

Learning Method and Assessment

The program adopts a mix learning strategy by combining lecture, discussion, and collaborative work approach. The students are targeted as the centre of the learning process. The assessment of the study progress is conducted based on the achievement of cumulative grade point and credits semester, along with the obligation to produce a master thesis and publish a scientific article in international journal.

Program

Master of Economics Diponegoro University offers two study options, Master of Economics by Course and Master of Economics by Research.

Curriculum

Currently, Master of Economics program still applies two curriculum systems namely the 2017 Curriculum and the 2020 Curriculum. The study is designed to be completed over four semesters or two years. The 2017 Curriculum is for those who enrolled before year 2020. It offers only a by course program consisting of regular class and collaboration class. In addition, the 2020 curriculum offers two study options, Master of Economic by course and Master of Economics by research. The curriculum is for those who enrolled in 2020 and thereafter. Total credit program ranges from 38 to 41. The detail of each of curriculum is described as follows:
